disabilities. This is not surprising, since nearly 20 percent of the population in the U.S. has a disability—that's nearly one in five people. Still, when the topic of website accessibility for the visually impaired was brought to my attention, I thought it was a joke. Turns out it's no joking matter as there are more than 7.3 million people in the U.S. who have varying degrees of blindness.

Making your website accessible to the impaired and disabled costs money, but refusing to do so is leading to increased litigation from advocacy groups that want access under the Americans with Disabilities Act, Title III. Website accessibility lawsuits and threatened claims have become big business for the plaintiffs' bar.¹ The number of lawsuits filed in federal court since the beginning of 2015 has surged to at least 244 as of Oct. 20, 2016.² Retailers have been the most popular targets, followed by restaurants and hospitality companies. Ninety-five percent of the lawsuits have been filed in Florida, Pennsylvania, New York and California federal courts.

Assistive technologies and adaptive strategies enable those with disabilities to participate in the online community and in e-commerce. Some examples of assistive technologies include:

- · screen readers that read webpages aloud;
- screen magnifiers to make text and graphics larger and easier to see;
- · voice-recognition software to assist with typing and commands; and
- scanning and switches systems that scan pages and allow the user to make a selection by hitting

Dear Congressman Budd:

This responds to your letter dated June 20, 2018, regarding website accessibility for public accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). We apologize for our delay in responding your letter.

As you may know, on December 26, 2017, the Department of Justice (the Department) published a Netice of Withdrawal of Four Previously Announced Rafemaking Actions in the Federal Register, 82 Fed. Reg. 60932 (Dec. 26, 2017). Two of the withdrawn rulomakings were related to the accessibility of web information and services under the ADA. The first withdrawn rulemaking (RIN 1190-AA61) covered accessibility of web information and services of public accommodations. The accent withdrawn rulemaking (RIN 1190-AA65) covered accessibility of web services of state and local governments.

As indicated in the Notice of Withdrawal, the Department is evaluating whether promulgating specific web accessibility standards through regulations is necessary and appropriate to ensure compliance with the ADA. The Department will also continue to reviv its entire regulatory landscape and associated agenda, pursuant to the regulatory reform provisions of Executive Order 13771, "Reducing Regulatory Reform Agenda."



This is a Job for Congress!


